Nominations of candidates for election to the Committee must be in writing and be received by the Secretary not less than twenty-eight days before the Annual General Meeting of the Club, with an intimation in writing that the candidates are willing to serve. A précis setting out the nominated person's background, etc. should also be supplied.

The business of the AGM will be as stated in the draft agenda unless a motion is received for additional business. Any such motion must be received by the Secretary 28 days prior to the AGM and be signed by at least three members.

### **ANNUAL ASC PRESENTATION DINNER**

Following the formal business of the AGM (which typically takes half to one hour) we will have the annual club *Presentation Dinner*. This is always a happy occasion with good company, and great food prepared by our House and Social Group. ### **CASA SAFETY SEMINAR**

There will be a CASA Safety Seminar in the clubhouse at Gawler this Thursday 20 July starting at 6.30 pm.

These are excellent and provide great information for all pilots whether new, old, experienced, glider, LSA or other. This one will deal with three major aviation safety related themes:

- flying within your limits
- making the RIGHT decisions in-flight
- hazards on arrival

As well as these main themes, the seminar will also provide a brief update on key safety messages and topics from AirServices Australia and the Bureau of Meteorology.
